

MONZA21 RULES for NON-COMPETITIVE RACES

The 19th edition of the Monza21 organized by Laguna Running SSDrl and MG Sport is an is an international race on distance 30km, 21,097Km,10Km and km that takes place in Monza on Sunday 22 October 2023 at h 9.00.

Along with the competitive races, the 10 km and 5 km "Non-Competitive" runs will also take place

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

Non-competitive runs:

- 10 km non-competitive run is of a "ludic-motor" nature, at a free pace and open to people of all ages and ability, provided they are in possession of a medical certificate of good health issued by a doctor. Anyone that wishes to run the 10km must be 13 years old on the day of the race. The registration to the "Non-Competitive" runs, constitutes an autographed declaration of the possession of this certificate and releases the Organizing Committee from future claims and any liability.
- 5 km Family Run is of a "ludic-motor" nature, at a free pace and are open to all people, as in possession of a medical certificate of good health issued by a doctor

All entrants taking part in the MONZA21 Half Marathon must accept and sign the following Waiver of Responsibility:

RELEASE, WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND AUTHORIZATION: 'I declare under penalty of perjury (art. 26 l. 15/68 and art. 489 c.p.) that: I have read and understood the Monza21 Half Marathon' race rules; I recognize that participation in the event is a potentially hazardous activity and I willingly assume all risks associated with such participation; I am aware that in registering to the event I must provide an active medical certificate for competitive athletics and be 18 years old on race day (13 for the 10 km); I am voluntarily entering and I hereby assume all of the risks of participating in this event: falls, contact with vehicles, other participants, spectators or other traffic, the effects of the weather, including heat and/or humidity, cold temperature, traffic and other conditions of the course, all such risks being known and appreciated by me.

Having read this waiver and knowing these facts, and in consideration of your acceptance of my application for the Monza21 Half Marathon, I, for myself and anyone entitled to act on my behalf, waive and release Laguna Running SSDrl, MG Sport srl, la Fidal, il GGG, Comune di Monza, Consorzio Villa Reale and Parco di Monza, Comune di Biassono, Provincia di Monza Brianza, Regione Lombardia, Autodromo Nazionale Monza, other partners, sponsors and their representatives, successors, shareholders, directors, officers and employees of the foregoing entities, from present and future claims and liabilities of any kind, known or unknown, arising out of my participation in the event.

I understand that the Monza21 Half Marathon entry fee is not refundable, not even in the event of the race cancellation or postponement, or due to any reason that cannot be attributed to the organizers, including revocation by public authorities. In registering to the event, I agree to allow my photo, video or film likeness to be used for any legitimate purpose by organizers, sponsors and assigns.

The registration fee includes: race bib, timing chip, race bag with official merchandise, sponsors merchandise, refreshment and sponging stations along the course and at the end of the race, toilets, parking, insurance, finisher's medal, finisher's certificate download, technical and medical assistance.

Online registration will close on Tuesday 17th October 2023 at 23.59 Should an athlete register in the last week before the event, the organization does not guarantee the race packet.

On Site Registration will be available on site at AREA PADDOCK

Saturday 21st: from 09:00 to 18:00 Sunday 22: from 07:00 to 08:30

Race number will be assigned based on the date of registration (first come first serve with a lower bib number).

Race bib can be picked-up by a third person, providing a written authorization and ID copy. Running clubs who make registrations through a collective form can request (at registration time) a collective race bib pick-up by a club representative; in this case race bib will not be delivered to single participants.

Race bib is strictly personal, cannot be rigged or transferred to anyone. Any participant found in the race course with a race bib assigned to another athlete or without any bib or with a forged one will be responsible for damage to himself, other people or items, and will incur in a sanction by the athletics federation officials.

The organizing committee reserves the right to close entries at its sole discretion, even earlier than the above deadline.

Payment of the entry fee must be made at the time of online registration with payment by credit card.

The Organizing Committee will send a formal registration confirmation document via e-mail to all registrants. If the confirmation e-mail does not arrive, the registrant should contact the registration secretariat at issaira iscrizioni@otc-srl.it
