- h 12.00 (approximate time) race end and final refreshment; AWARDS.






Maps

Route Map - 10 km









General info

Race packet and bib collection

Race bibs may be collected at the secretariat inside the Expo Village located at the Allianz MiCo (**Gate 4** entrance, viale Scarampo) on the following days and times:

- Friday 24 November from 3.00 pm to 7.00 pm
- Saturday 25 November from 10.00 a.m. to 7.00 p.m.
- Sunday 22 October from 07.00 to 8.30*.

*In order to guarantee the best possible flow and avoid unpleasant inconveniences on race day, the collection of the bib number and race package on Sunday is only permitted to residents outside the province of Milan.

The bib number will be communicated by **ENDU** via e-mail.

Bibs may also be collected by third parties, with a written proxy and a photocopy of a valid identity document.

Athletes are requested, in order to guarantee them maximum safety and assistance, to fill in the back of the bib number with the information indicated: blood group and emergency number.

Starting grids and bib colours

COMPETITIVE RACES And 21km Turistic-Sporting goals

The starting sector for each athlete is assigned on the basis of the best personal time declared at the time of registration, and will be indicated by the appropriate identification colour of the bib. Four starting grids will be set up:

Grid 1 BLUE, Griglia 2 YELLOW, Griglia 3 RED, Griglia 4 WHITE

However, the organising committee reserves the right to possibly move some athletes from one sector to another according to organisational contingencies.

10KM NON COMPETITIVE RACE

For non-competitive events, a dedicated starting grid will be set up by the organisers at the end of the competitive events, identified by the colour **GREEN**.

BIB COLOURS

21 KM competitive: RED bib, 21KM tourist-sporting: BIANCO bib, 10 KM competitive: YELLOW bib, 10 KM non competitive: VERDE bib.





Refreshments

The following refreshments and sponges are provided:

21 km: km 5: water; km 10: salts, banana, supplements; km 12.5: sponging;

km 15: salts, banana, supplements; km 17.5: sponging; km 20: water and salts.

10 km: km 5: water and salts.

There will also be a final refreshment service after the finish area, with liquids, salts, sweet and salty solid food, fruit.

Time limits

For the scheduled races, the following time limits apply:

21 km: 2 hours 45 minutes
10 km: 1 hour 30 minutes

Services present

PACERS: present on 21km, from 1.20h to 2.30h every 5 minuti.

BAGS DEPOSIT: located inside the Allianz MiCo; the service can be used service

ONLY with the special netted bag provided by the organisation.

The bag depot will close at 8.40 a.m, we invite athletes to calculate well the time needed to reach the start (300 metres away, in Via Arona)

CHANGES ROOMS & WC: present inside the Allianz MiCo. 20 chemical toilets at the start.

SHOWERS: NOT present

MASSAGES: present in the Expo Area on Sunday, and on Saturday by appointment (info@sportandrehab.it, 3517808668)

Timekeeping and rankings

The measurement of times and processing of rankings will be carried out using a transponder chip system.

Prizes will be awarded by the organising committee:

 Competitive 21Km: prizes in kind for the first 5 absolute men and 5 absolute women, and prizes in kind for the first 3 men and women in each category

Men JU, SM35, SM40, SM45, SM50, SM55, SM60, SM65, SM70, SM75 and above.

• Competitive 10Km: in-kind prizes for the first 5 absolute men and 5 absolute women

Teams prizes

QUANTITY CLASSIFICATION

Prizes will be awarded to the first five classified teams. The rankings will be obtained by taking into account the number of registered participants of the same club over the competitive 21 and 10 km distances. The following prize money will be awarded

TIME CLASSIFICATION - 21 KM ONLY

Prizes will be awarded to the first 5 classified companies. The rankings will be obtained by adding up the 5 times obtained by the first 4 male athletes plus the first female athlete from the same club. The following prizes will be awarded

Logistic info

How to arrive

The Milano21 Expo Village will be set up at the Allianz MiCo

The start and finish are located in Via Arona, a few minutes' walk from the Expo Village.

BY METRO (recommended)

The start/finish line and the Expo area are easily reached by metro stop **Portello**, Metro 5 LILLA.

BY TRAIN

From Central Station (FS) and Garibaldi Station (FS) it is possible to reach the departure/arrival point and the Expo area by taking the metro line LILLA M5 Portello stop.

BY CAR

There are no affiliated car parks.

For those coming from outside Milan we recommend leaving your car at the ATM car parks near the main metro stops:

M1 Red Line: Molino Dorino, Lampugnano, Bisceglie

M2 Green Line: Famagosta, Romolo, Crescenzago, Cascina Gobba, Cologno Nord, Gessate.






Photo service

With GetPica your race's photos immediately on your smartphone

With the GetPica service, all participants will be able to receive their photos directly on their smartphone, immediately after the race and in full respect of privacy. The photos will be available during and immediately after the race. Once you have logged in to the app (or the getpica.com website) and entered the code shown on the bib, you will be able to see and purchase them.

The photos purchased will initially be in lower resolution to have the possibility of immediately sharing them online with your friends and relatives (in any case in a good and clearly visible resolution), the following day the photos will be available in high resolution (obviously without any additional cost).

During the event PhotoToday will photograph all the runners along the route several times and at the finish.

What should the athlete do?

1. Wear the code

Wear the sticker code that is provided to you or that is printed on your bib.

2. Run

Stay focused but smile when, during the race, you meet one of the photographers present.

3. Download the app
